ENGLISH LANGUAGE PROFICIENCY.

- IELTS 5.5 (with no subtest under 4.5)
- Equivalent results on an “internationally recognised test”
- Duolingo online test results acceptable
- Academique English Placement test result of 70% or above

EDUCATION PROOF

- completed high school is generally adequate.



Students study between 3 to 7 units across an eight-study week term then have a 2 week “Research Break”. Students are required to participate in the training as a condition of their visa.

Students must log a minimum of 400 supervised, ‘paid’ or ‘unpaid’, work experience hours.

The student is responsible for collecting evidence proving the supervised ‘paid’ work experience hours. Supervised ‘unpaid’ work experience placements must be approved by the General Manager before starting the work experience hours. We can help you to find suitable “Vocational Placement”.


